We have recently had two board members give us their resignations. Eugene Tseng had to leave to serve in Taiwan in the Army, as part of his civic duty, and will be starting law school at Columbia in January. Ian Cocroft has accepted a position as a research associate for the Democratic National Committee, and will be in Washington DC much of the time. Please join us in congratulating both of them on their valuable service to our council, and their continued success and accomplishments. We wish both of them all the best. They have left big shoes to fill.

With this news, we find ourselves with two open seats on our board! These seats are both RENTER seats, which means that to qualify, one must rent within our neighborhood council boundaries. These boundaries can be found on our website, but they are basically, Sunset to the North, Santa Monica to the South, Beverly Glen to the East, and Sepulveda to the West.

Per our bylaws, we must post these positions for at least 60 days prior to selecting two new board members. We spoke about this at our October meeting, and it was determined that instead of selecting in December, we would do so in January 2017, instead. The reason for this is to give fair opportunity to UCLA, and other students, that may be interested and qualified for these positions. Since so many students are away at this time of year, visiting family or on vacation, we felt it would be most prudent and fair to select these seats in January.

For those of you interested in applying, please submit to us via email that you are interested by January 3, 2017. You must be able to show proof of your renter status within our boundaries. Of those interested, we would ask that you be in attendance at our January 11 2017 7 PM meeting to give a short presentation as to why you would be a good fit for our council. If you cannot be there in person, you may submit a form that can be read aloud during the board meeting.

Our existing board will then "select" by majority vote, two members to fill these open seats. When selected, you will become a member of the board immediately!
