Postpone Caltrans Repaving Project on the 405

Motion

“ The Westwood Neighborhood Council, a member of the Westside Regional Alliance of Councils (WRAC), urgently requests that Caltrans delay the I-405 Pavement Rehabilitation Project (<https://dot.ca.gov/caltrans-near-me/district-7/district-7-news/d7-caltrans-to-host-meeting-for-the-interstate-405-sepulveda-pass-pavementrehabilitation-project>) until after:

“1) All lanes of Pacific Coast Highway are reopened, and

“2) All Palisades fire debris removal is complete.

“The Westwood Neighborhood Council believes that this delay is reasonable given that the I-405 Pavement Rehabilitation project is scheduled to take four years, and we ask that Caltrans accommodate this important request.

“The Westwood Neighborhood Council further requests that Councilmembers representing WRAC member councils (Park, Yaroslavsky, Hutt and/or Raman) bring a resolution in Council to effectuate this request on behalf of the City.”
