Postpone Caltrans Repaving Project on the 405

Motion

- "The Westwood Neighborhood Council, a member of the Westside Regional Alliance of Councils (WRAC), urgently requests that Caltrans delay the I-405 Pavement Rehabilitation Project (https://dot.ca.gov/caltrans-near-me/district-7/district-7-news/d7-caltrans-to-host-meeting-for-the-interstate-405-sepulveda-pass-pavementrehabilitation-project) until after:
- "1) All lanes of Pacific Coast Highway are reopened, and
- "2) All Palisades fire debris removal is complete.
- "The Westwood Neighborhood Council believes that this delay is reasonable given that the I-405 Pavement Rehabilitation project is scheduled to take four years, and we ask that Caltrans accommodate this important request.
- "The Westwood Neighborhood Council further requests that Councilmembers representing WRAC member councils (Park, Yaroslavsky, Hutt and/or Raman) bring a resolution in Council to effectuate this request on behalf of the City."
